

COVID-19 ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE GUIDANCE



IF YOU TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS

Isolate at home for 5 days. After 5 days, if you are not experiencing symptoms **OR** symptoms are resolving **AND** you are fever free for 24 hours, you may return to school or work as long as you agree to wear a mask day 6 through day 10.

If the positive case does not agree to wear a mask, they must isolate at home for 10 days.

IF YOU WERE EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19 REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS

Option 1: Remain in school or work as long as you are not experiencing symptoms and agree to wear a mask for 10 days following exposure, **OR**

Option 2: Quarantine for 5 days. After 5 days, you may return to school or work as long as you are not experiencing symptoms and agree to wear a mask day 6 through day 10.

If the close contact does not agree to wear a mask, they must quarantine at home for 10 days.

IF YOU ARE A HOUSEHOLD CONTACT OF A POSITIVE CASE

Please note: Fully vaccinated household contacts can remain in school or work as long as they are not experiencing symptoms and agree to wear a mask for 10 days following exposure.

Option 1 for unvaccinated household contacts: Quarantine for 5 days, then test on day 5 or after at a formal testing site or health care facility. Once a documented negative test is received, you may return to school or work. When returning to school or work, you agree to wear a mask through day 10, **OR**

Option 2 for unvaccinated household contacts: Quarantine for 10 days. You may return to school or work on day 11.

If the household contact does not agree to wear a mask, they must quarantine at home for 10 days.
