Articulation Agreement Between

Great Lakes Institute of Technology

And

Corry Career and Technical Education Center

Effective Date: July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2024

Great Lakes Institute of Technology (GLIT) and Corry Career and Technical Education Center (CCTEC) enter into the following general articulation agreement to provide "Diversified Occupations" students with the opportunity to earn advanced placement credit toward completion of the Accounting Clerk, Administrative Office Professional, Health Information Technology and Surgical Technologist.

GLIT will award academic credit to CCTEC graduates who have demonstrated mastery of the agreed competencies by passing the comprehensive final for each course identified below with a 70% or better.

Program	Course	Credits
Surgical Technologist	EN121 Business Communication	3 credits
Medical Billing Specialist	EN111 Business Communication	2 credits

Credits award as a result of this agreement will appear as "Transfer Credit" on the student's official GLIT transcript. Credits will count toward completion of the prescribed GLIT program, but will not be used when calculating the student's grade average or calculating satisfactory academic progress. All applicants are required to meet GLIT admissions requirements, as defined in the school catalog.

Students will not be charged tuition for the advanced placement credits earned as a result of this agreement. CCTC graduates who wish to apply for advanced placement under the terms of this agreement must send a written request to the GLIT admissions department a minimum of 30 days prior to the commencement of courses.

GLIT and CCTC will agree to review annually the provisions contained in this agreement. GLIT and CCTC will alter the provisions of this agreement only upon mutual written consent. It is understood that any revision will not adversely affect students already covered under the provisions of the existing agreement.

Either party may terminate this agreement upon six months written notification to the other party. Students In progress will be permitted to complete the program, should such termination of agreement occur.
