

Articulation Agreement Between
Great Lakes Institute of Technology

And

Corry Area School District

Great Lakes Institute of Technology (GLIT) and Corry Area School District (CASD) enter into the following general articulation agreement to provide CASD Health Occupations students with the opportunity to earn advanced placement credit toward completion of the Health Information Technology (degree), Massage Therapist (diploma), Medical Assistant (diploma), Medical Office Assistant (diploma), Practical Nursing (diploma), and Surgical Technologist (degree) programs.

GLIT will award academic credit to CASD graduates who have demonstrated mastery of the agreed competencies by passing the comprehensive final for each course identified below with a 70% or better.

MD141 Medical Terminology & Anatomy II	4 credits


Credits award as a result of this agreement will appear as "Test Out" credits on the student's official GLIT transcript, and credits will count toward completion of the prescribed GLIT program. All applicants are required to meet GLIT admissions requirements, as defined in the school catalog.

Students will not be charged tuition for the advanced placement credits earned as a result of this agreement. CASD graduates who wish to apply for advanced placement under the terms of this agreement must send a written request to the GLIT admissions department a minimum of 30 days prior to the commencement of the program.

GLIT and CASD will agree to review annually the provisions contained in this agreement. GLIT and CASD will alter the provisions of this agreement only upon mutual written consent. It is understood that any revision will not adversely affect students already covered under the provisions of the existing agreement.


Either party may terminate this agreement upon six months written notification to the other party. Students in progress will be permitted to complete the program, should such termination of agreement occur.
