This is a 3-year program in which students learn how to care for patients in an outpatient and inpatient setting. They are taught how to initiate a chart; care for the patient's needs; and assist with activities of daily living, as well as learn assessment tools. Teamwork within the medical setting is stressed. Professionalism is explained, modeled, and expected. Patient safety is our priority and practice. At completion of the program, students take the NOCTI exam. Here the students are learning to work as a team with visual, speech and physical limitations to complete a task.
