The student may challenge LBI/LTI's first semester courses with a skills demonstration and theory exam for each course at no cost to the student. The evaluation will be conducted by the Cosmetology Director or Supervisor at each location. Any course for which the student scores 85% or higher will advance place the student for that class. Student will complete the remainder of the courses on their program sheet as an LBI/LTI student, receiving a letter grade for each class. Hours completed at LBI/LTI will be added to the student's record at the State Board of Cosmetology.</p>

May challenge LBI/LTI first and/or second semester cosmetology courses with a skills demonstration and theory exam for each course at no cost to the student. Any course for which the student scores 85% or higher may advance place up to 49% (661 hours) of their program. Student will complete the remainder of the courses on the program sheet as an LBI/LTI student, receiving a letter grade for each class. Hours completed at LBI/LTI will be added to the students record at the State Board of Cosmetology.</p>
<p>More than 1000 hours at any vocational school</p>	<p>Complete hours needed to sit for license exam.</p>	<p>A student that has already tested with the State Board of Cosmetology and wishes to complete their hours in order to receive their license must provide an official transcript from their previous school, a copy of their NOCTI results, and the completed PA state board affidavit from their prior school. The student will also meet with the Cosmetology Director to discuss the assigned days and hours the student will attend to complete. Once the hours completed at LBI/LTI are verified by the Program Director or Supervisor, they will be recorded at the State Board of Cosmetology. The Program Director or supervisor will complete the final affidavit and send all required paperwork to the State Board for the student to receive their license. Students will pay an hourly rate to complete hours needed to sit for State Board Licensure. No LBI/LTI diploma will be awarded.</p>
