Dear Students, Parents, and Guardians,

You will find enclosed packets of educational materials for each of your courses. With the Memorial Day Holiday and the need for the paper packets to be returned to teachers for evaluation prior to the close of the school year, the District made the decision to combine Cycle 4 and Cycle 5 (Monday, May 11, 2020 to Thursday, June 4, 2020) of our Continuity of Education Plan. The enclosed packets continue with planned instruction. Planned instruction means that new content for your classes is being provided in order to close out your courses and you will have assignments which need to be submitted.

Our expectation is that you will make a good faith effort to participate by reviewing the new content and completing all of the activities to the best of your ability. A return envelope has been included for you to return your packets once you have completed them. When you are done with your packets, place them in the envelope and return to the drop box in front of the Middle-High School. Please make sure your name and grade are written on the top of each of your packets when you return them. In addition, your teachers may communicate other ways that you are able to submit your assignments, such as taking a picture of the assignment when finished and emailing it to the teacher if you have that capability. All materials for this cycle and any previous cycle are due to be returned by Tuesday, June 2, 2020.

Your work will continue to be evaluated based on your participation and completion of the required assignments and the grading system will be Pass/Fail for the 4th nine weeks. At the conclusion of the 4th nine weeks, if you receive a Pass score, you will earn a 100% for that nine weeks. If you receive a Fail score, which could happen if you don't complete the assignments/activities/assessments appropriately, you will receive a 67%. If you choose not to participate at all, your grade will reflect that effort.

As you work through the materials, we are here to support you. If you have any questions regarding the materials and activities enclosed, your first contact should be your teacher directly through their email or calling their extension at the school.
